Councillor Alison Magee Launches Inverness Community TV

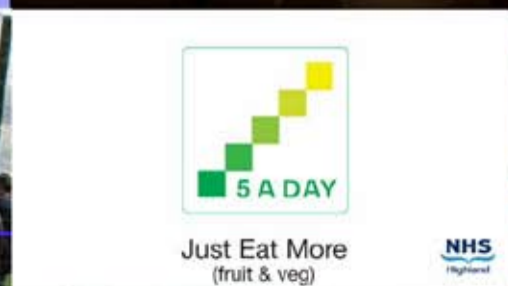
